Duration: Five days (From 27-03-19 to 31-03-19)

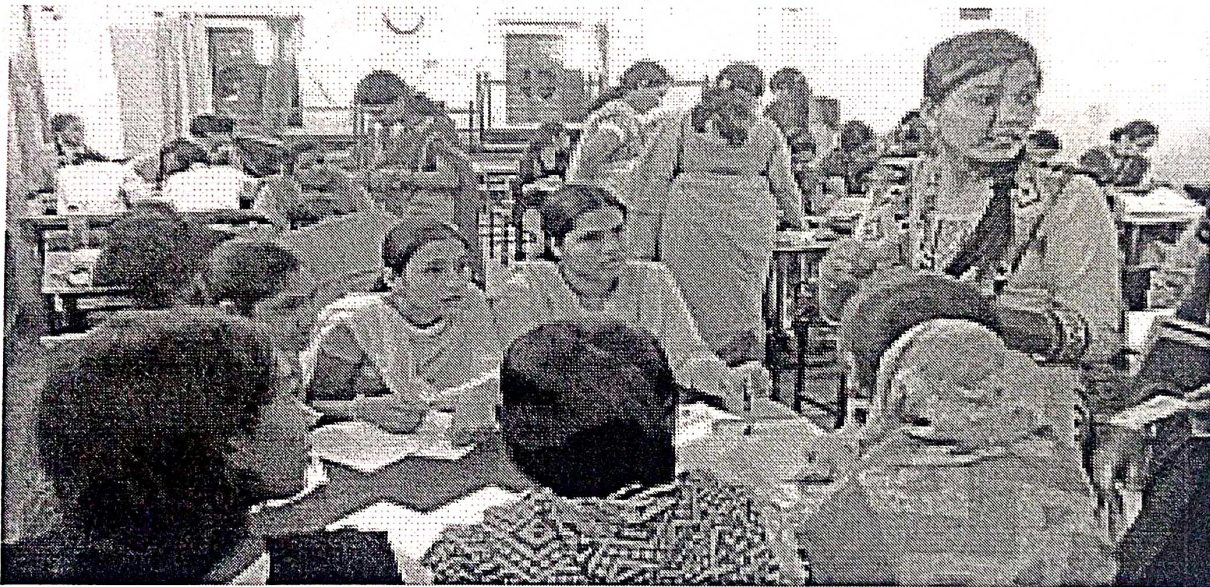
Objective:
